

# 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday Walks

## Houndkirk and Higger

Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2019, 10:30

**This is an easy circular walk of approximately six miles with no major hills.**

Starting in Upper Burbage Bridge we head towards Ringinglow along the road then cut across the moor to Ox Stones before dropping down to Houndkirk Road. At the very top of Houndkirk Road, we turn right and head across to Carl Wark then up to Higger Tor and back to the car park.

This route drops over Burbage Edge, and the last time I saw this it was a waterfall, so there is an alternative route back along the top of Burbage Rocks – this is also the shortcut if anybody is tired. The whole walk follows well marked paths and ancient roads but could still be very muddy in places (well used means the mud is well churned up!).

Bring your sandwiches and we can stop near Burbage Edge (either above or below depending on which gives more shelter from the wind).

**Starting point** is the Upper Burbage Bridge car park, Ringinglow Rd, **S32 1BR**.
